

# **Heart and Stroke Foundation 2010 Becel Heart&Stroke Ride for Heart – Niagara-On-The-Lake Cycling Getaway Package RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **HOW TO ENTER**

1. The contest starts at 9:00 a.m. EST on Thursday January 21, 2010 (the “Contest Start Date”) and ends at 11:59 p.m. EST on Monday, June 14, 2010 (the “Contest Closing Date”).
2. TO QUALIFY: Individuals must register for the 2010 Becel Heart&Stroke Ride for Heart AND fundraise \$300 or more no later than the “Contest Closing Date”.
3. TO ENTER: Participants are automatically entered into the contest to win once they have registered for the 2010 Becel Heart&Stroke Ride for Heart AND have fundraised \$300 or more before the “Contest Closing Date”. Duplicate entries will be void and will disqualify original entry

## **ELIGIBILITY**

1. This contest is open only to 2010 Becel Heart&Stroke Ride for Heart participants except for employees of Heart and Stroke Foundation, Raleigh Canada and their affiliates, their advertising and promotional agencies, and person with whom they are domiciled. Parents/ Guardians of children under 18 years of age must sign a consent form. Only individuals that register for the event AND fundraise \$300 or more before the “Contest Closing Date” will be eligible to win.

## **THE PRIZE**

There is one (1) grand prize that includes: Niagara-On-The-Lake Cycling Getaway Package for two (2) people; two (2) Diamondback Bikes; and two (2) round trip Toronto-Niagara Greenbelt Express Bike Train tickets. The selected entrant will be required to sign a standard declaration and release form confirming compliance with the contest rules, acceptance of the prize as awarded and releasing the contest suppliers from all liability.
